Jake has had particular success challenging unlawful government action, including numerous high-profile victories against state and local governments. For example, Jake has successfully protected the healthcare rights of hundreds of thousands of retired New York City municipal employees, saving them, to date, over \$2 billion in health insurance expenses. He has achieved similar groundbreaking victories for active and retired civil servants in other parts of the country. Jake is outside counsel to the Uniformed Fire Officers Association (the union for lieutenants, captains, chiefs, medical officers, and supervising fire marshals in the New York City Fire Department) and the NYC Organization of Public Service Retirees (the organization representing the interests of approximately 250,000 retired New York City municipal employees).

Jake maintains an active pro bono practice and has served as a member of the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit's pro bono panel. He has represented on appeal and retrial indigent defendants convicted of murder. He also worked with the New York State Justice Task Force to prevent wrongful convictions and assisted with the filing of a civil rights class action on behalf of indigent criminal defendants deprived of their right to counsel.

Before joining WMHW, Jake practiced law at a preeminent global firm, where he assisted with internal FCPA and securities fraud investigations and handled complex commercial disputes. He also served for several years as a New York City firefighter, assigned to Ladder 43 in East Harlem.
