He serves, after appointment by Mayor Eric Adams, as Chair of the Conflicts of Interest Board for the City of New York and serves as the Vice Chair of the Attorney Grievance Committee for the First Judicial Department. He previously served as co-chair of the Moreland Commission to Investigate Public Corruption.
